

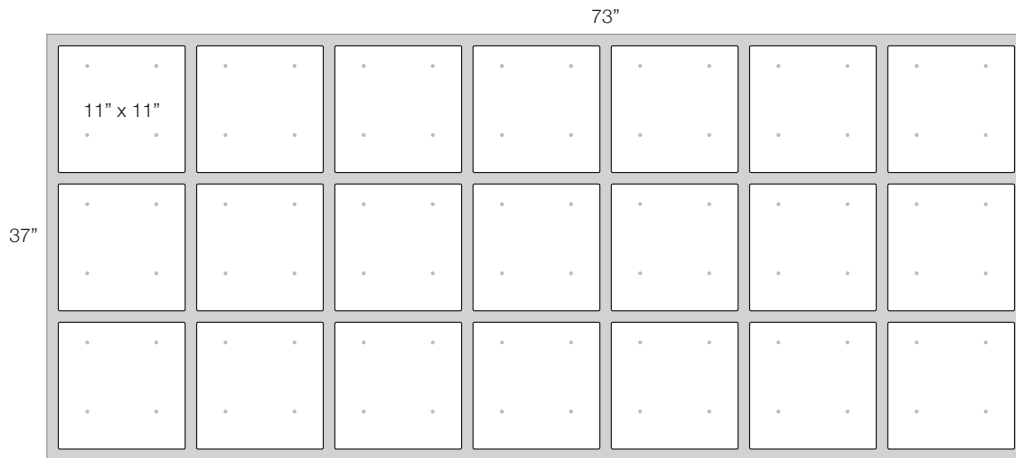
Backer board solutions

When you want to install a CollageWall display on a brick or masonry wall, first attach a backer board then insert the pegs on it. We recommend 3/8" or 1/2" thick board. Both plywood and particle board work fine, but particle board is easier to finish. Make sure your order includes the drill bit you'll need to make pilot holes.

If you want to mount the largest possible CollageWall display on a backer board cut from a standard 8' x 4' board, consider these sizing recommendations.

Recommended

A.
Pictures fit inside backer board with the 1" margin, matching the 1" margin between the pictures.



Recommended

B.
Pictures extend past edge of backer board by 1/2".
Don't make the setback larger than 1/2" or the flaps that hold smaller pictures off the wall may not work quite right.



Not Recommended

A.
Cut from single 8'x4' board.
Pictures fit inside backer board with the 1/2" margin, different than the 1" margin between the pictures.
