1. Unpack the contents of your order and gather the tools you'll need:







If you have a hard plaster wall, you will also need a drill.





2. Cozy up to the wall with your web browser and visit:

Unless you do this step, some panels will flop about and hang at an angle.

To the panels that span 1, 2 or 3 pegs, attach adhesive foam spacers to the back corners as shown above – on the paper.

Now these panels will hang parallel to the wall and hold tight.
